**saving water**

- Make sure any water taps are completely turned off when not in use
- Do not let water run unnecessarily
- Take showers rather than baths
- Choose the small shower-head rather than the rain shower
- Re-use your bath / pool towels and leave them on the floor only when they really need replacing; our policy is to change them even other day
- Inform the reception immediately about toilet / bath leaks.

**saving energy**

- ..Close all windows and doors when the ventilation (A/C or heating) is in use
- Turn off the lights and ventilation when leaving the room
- Avoid leaving room devices on standby when not in use
- Avoid overheating or overcooling the room (26° C is an ideal year-round room temperature)
- Unplug your personal device chargers when they are not being used
- Opt for natural light to artificial lighting
- Turn off electrical devices when they are not in use
- Report electrical malfunctions for prompt repairs.

**reducing waste**

- We will always supply you with additional room amenities upon request e.g. solid soap, room slippers, etc. but would appreciate your help in keeping this to a minimum
- If you purchase packaged items like water from super-markets, opt for larger containers with more capacity.

**recycling**

- Please leave your recyclable waste (paper, cartons, batteries, glass, plastic) in the dustbin provided and it will be collected when your room is serviced.

In recognition of the fact that its environmental footprint spans across the hotel’s day-to-day operations, the Alion Beach Hotel has pledged to continuously improve its performance in the areas of energy efficiency, renewable energy use, water conservation, waste minimization and recycling, sustainable procurement, community integration, respect of the local culture, human rights awareness, and finally, education about discrimination and child abuse.

**Examples of the actions taken include:**

- Replacing conventional light bulbs with LED light bulbs in most areas
- Installation of solar panels to provide energy for the pools
- Installation of low- low water taps in rooms
- Implementation of a measurement tool for food waste coming out of our kitchen
- Recycling renewable waste like plastic, metal, batteries etc.
- Purchasing from local suppliers as much as possible, especially for our ‘Cyprus Authentic Breakfast’
- Supporting the local community with various donations
- Conducting in-house training in the areas of human rights, discrimination and child abuse.
